

# **Balloon-assisted enteroscopy**

**A test for identifying diseases of the small intestine. With the help of a balloon located at the endoscope, the small intestine is pulled onto the endoscope, and the endoscope is advanced inside the intestine in this way.**

During the examination, it is possible to take tissue samples and perform treatment procedures, if necessary (taking a biopsy, polypectomy). Since the procedure may take a long time, it is usually performed under anaesthesia and in the day treatment ward.
