

# Appointment with an Endocrinologist

Endocrinologists consult patients in the following disease groups:

1. Type 1 diabetes from age 19;
2. Type 2 diabetes with complex treatment regimens and advanced stage of illness;
3. Treatment of gestational diabetes;
4. Diagnosis and treatment of hyperthyroidism;
5. Diagnosis and treatment of thyroid nodules;
6. Diagnosis of thyroid malignancies, we refer to surgery;
7. Diagnosis and treatment of thyroid disorders during pregnancy;
8. Obese patients who wish to have bariatric surgery or need a consultation on weight-loss methods;
9. Patients with benign neoplasms of the pituitary gland – patients with acromegaly, i.e. tumours producing growth hormone, prolactinomas – diagnosis and treatment;
10. Patients with hypopituitarism who need diagnostic tests and replacement therapy;
11. Hormonally active tumours of the adrenal glands which cause elevated blood pressure – diagnosis, referral to surgery, if necessary;
12. Patients with adrenal insufficiency, diagnosis and replacement therapy;
13. Patients with hyperparathyroidism – the disease often manifests as an elevated calcium level in the blood and osteoporosis;
14. Hormonal changes related to infertility;
15. Diagnosis of hormonally active tumours elsewhere in the organism, we refer to surgery;
16. Endocrinologists perform thyroid ultrasound scans with a thyroid biopsy for cytology, if necessary;
17. Endocrinologists perform dynamic diagnostic tests for more specific disease diagnostics.
